



Parameters for Educational Reform – 1992

Resolved: That the Alaska PTA opposes any educational reform plan which:

- uses public funds for private schools;
- fails to guarantee an excellent education for those students who do not, or can not “Choose”;
- fails to guarantee equal access;
- causes any public school to become unable to compete as a result of student and financial loss;
- leads to segregation by race, socioeconomic class or disability;
- fails to meet constitutional, as well as federal, state and local educational mandates;
- fails to provide for meaningful parental involvement;
- fails to provide for an evaluation process to determine the effectiveness of the program.
